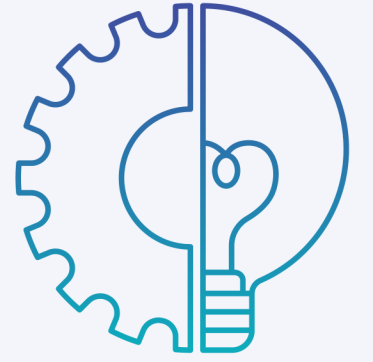

Introduction

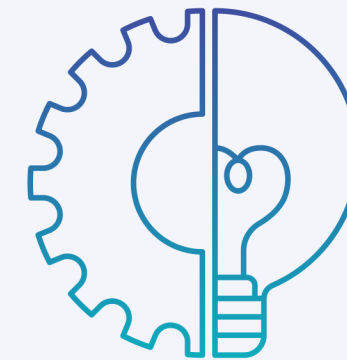

USAL suggests the following programs:

Mobility within the Framework of Agreements

The postgraduate students enrolled in a university or other institution of higher education that has signed a Collaboration Agreement with USAL could complete a full academic year or a semester in USAL.

Erasmus Student Mobility for Studies

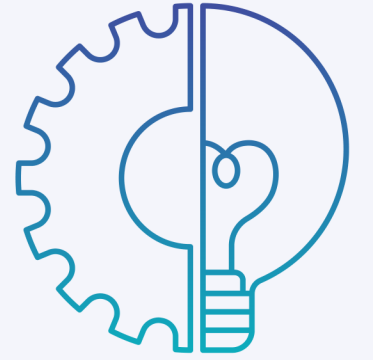
USAL in corporation with Erasmus plus provides to students the opportunity to study in their degree-related abroad for 3- 12 months.

MEUS suggests the following programs:



01 Eurodyssey

Eurodyssey provides the people, who are looking for a job and are between 18 and 30 years old, the choice to work in a vocational training course in an organization or company abroad for 3- 7 months.



02 European Voluntary Service

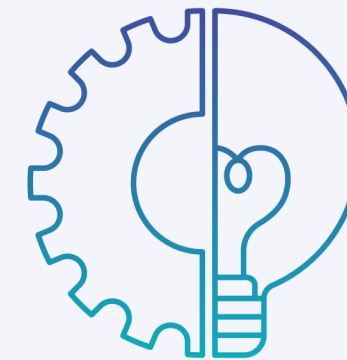
EVS program is addressed to young people between the age of 18-30, who want to improve their soft skills.

EUNICE Student Physical Mobility

This program provides the students of all disciplines the opportunity to complete 1- 2 semesters abroad.

Bureau de Coopération Interuniversitaire (BCI – Office of Interuniversity Cooperation)

The academic institutions of Quebec, through the BCI, have created exchange programs for students.

01 Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs

The program is funded by the European Commission and helps young people, who want to be entrepreneurs, to improve their skills by starting or running a company in Europe, in collaboration with an experienced entrepreneur.



02 International Credit Mobility Erasmus+ KA107

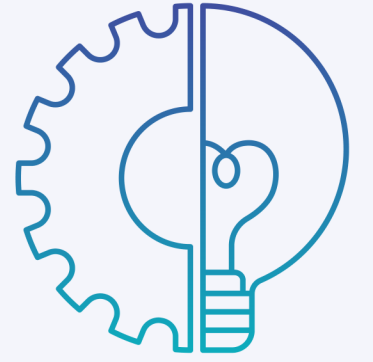
The International Credit Mobility Erasmus+ KA107 provides the opportunity for students to move for studies or internships to another country.

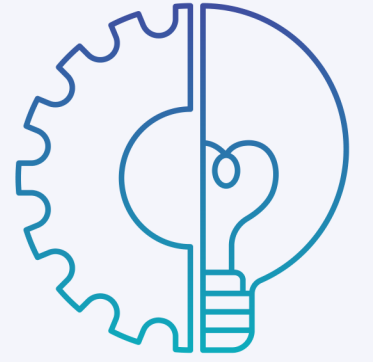
HUMANITAS

02

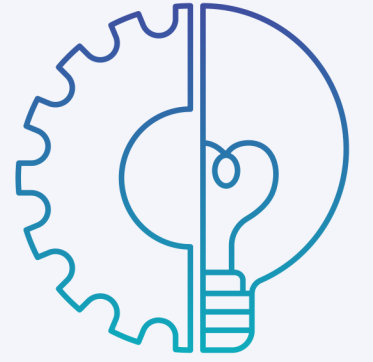
Nordplus Higher Education Program

Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters

The Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility concern both students and the university staff from European institutions of higher education that have agreements with the University of Turku.



02

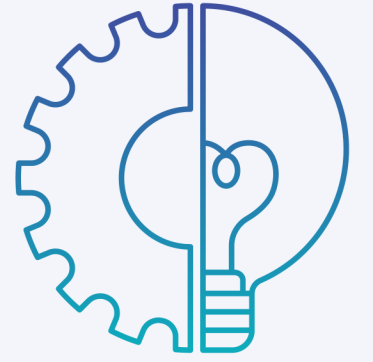
Nordplus

The main assumption is that the students must have studied for at least one year at their home institution except for the students who are studying in a joint master's program or in express mobility.
